# CHICKEN WITH

LEMON POTATOES \$7.50 Succulent breast of chicken baked Greek style with golden potatoes roasted in a lemon garlic broth.



DOLMATHES \$2.50 each (dol-MA-des) –Tender grape leaves stuffed with a savory meat and rice filling, bathed in a tangy egg-lemon sauce.



GREEK SALAD \$4.50 Tossed with traditional Greek dressing and topped with feta cheese and black olives.



KEFTEDES \$2.50 each (kef-te-DES) – Traditional spiced Greek meatballs. Crispy, juicy and delicious!



MOUSSAKA \$8.00 (mouh-sa-KA) – Layers of young eggplant and sautéed ground beef baked with a rich cream sauce (béchamel).

(kou-ram-BEH-des) – Light buttered cookies sprinkled with confectionery sugar.




